#### Tickets now on sale for World Science Festival Brisbane 2025

The highly anticipated program for World Science Festival Brisbane 2025 has been officially launched, unveiling an exciting lineup of events that will transform the city into a vibrant hub of science and creativity.

From 21 to 30 March, the festival will celebrate its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary with more than 200 sessions delving into a range of topics, from groundbreaking scientific discoveries to engaging discussions and interactive experiences.

Commemorating 100 years since the initial development of quantum mechanics, this year's festival embraces the theme of **Infinite Awe** with programming responding to questions larger than our humanity and tackling some of the pressing questions of our time, including First Nations knowledges, space exploration and the future of quantum.

Taking place at iconic venues across the city, including **Queensland Museum**, the **Cultural Precinct, South Bank Piazza**, **Fish Lane**, and throughout Greater Brisbane, the festival will showcase some of the most brilliant minds in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM).

In celebration of its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary, the festival will include special programming in **Ipswich**, with the opening weekend featuring a two-day *Robots and Rocketry* event, including the return of **Robowars**. at **Queensland Museum Rail Workshops in North Ipswich**.

As part of its ongoing mission to educate and inspire, the festival will once again tour regional Queensland, visiting Ipswich, Toowoomba, Gladstone, Chinchilla, and Townsville—taking the excitement of scientific discovery beyond the city limits.

**Queensland Museum CEO Dr Jim Thompson** said World Science Festival Brisbane 2025 will be a celebration of the pursuit of knowledge, a festival for all ages.

"Over the past ten years, World Science Festival Brisbane has grown into one of the leading science events in the Southern Hemisphere, sparking interest and inspiring generations," Dr Thompson said.

"This year's program will continue that tradition, exploring the wonders of the universe and the power of human ingenuity.

"Whether you're a science enthusiast, enjoy learning, curious about the world around us or the parent of a budding scientist, there's something here for everyone."

**Minister for Education and the Arts John-Paul Langbroek** said World Science Festival Brisbane is a highlight of Queensland's events calendar and reinforces the Museum's commitment to sharing one of its flagship festivals with metropolitan and regional audiences.

"The Crisafulli Government is proud to support this popular festival as it celebrates its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary," Minister Langbroek said.
